

Visual Guide to Official Washington State Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination



COVID-19 vaccination is required by many businesses, events and employers. The following types of proof are accepted in Washington. Some locations may only accept one specific type from this list below.

Respect the rules of the room and be prepared in advance to show the type of proof requested.

CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card

- Originals, copies or photographs on a mobile device are acceptable.
- Full vaccination is valid two weeks after the last recorded dose:
 - Single dose for Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) vaccine.
 - Two doses of Pfizer-BioNTech/Comirnaty or Moderna vaccine.

Certificate of COVID-19 Vaccination or Digital QR Codes

Available from MyIRmobile.com.

- **Sample A:** Certificate of COVID-19 Vaccination
- **Sample B:** MyIRMobile QR Code
- **Sample C:** QR Code displayed on an endorsed partner mobile app. (Apps may vary)



WA State Immunization Information System printout

- Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) forms printed from the Washington State Immunization Information System.
- Hand-written entries are not considered valid unless signed by a licensed medical provider.

What else counts as an official record of COVID-19 vaccination?

- Verified electronic medical record printout from a medical provider
